

**WEEKLY UPDATE AND NOTIFICATION OF NEW CASE**

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. Since the onset of this pandemic we have had 44 residents and 26 staff test positive for COVID-19. We currently have no residents in the building with Covid-19. All but 1 staff member have returned to work.

We are testing based on our county's current percentage of Covid-19. The current status requires Twice per week for all employees. We completed this week's testing on Tuesday and today and one employee tested positive.

As always, we are working hard to keep everyone in our community safe and we will continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC. Staff is frequently reminded and encouraged to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community. We ask them not to report to work if they have symptoms of illness. We offer outside visits for residents, these visits are available on Wednesday and Thursday with four time slots (weather permitting):

9:15 a.m. - 9:45 a.m.  
10:00 a.m. - 10:45 a.m.  
12:15 p.m. - 1:00 p.m.  
1:15 p.m. - 1:45 p.m.

Please continue to check our website for weekly updates as well as notification of new cases. As always, we will notify you if we receive confirmation of a new positive case in our facility and we will reach out to you individually if your loved one is displaying symptoms of COVID-19 or tests positive for COVID-19.
